I am a physician duly licensed in the province of Ontario. I have generated this letter at the request of my patient Charlie Smith's wife, Jane. Mr. Smith is a patient in the Baycrest Ross Memory Clinic, followed by me for frontotemporal dementia. As a result of this illness, he has difficulty communicating, inconsistently able to understand and follow verbal commands without visual or physical prompts, and he has developed some compulsive behaviours, such as needing to rise and go to the washroom frequently.
